**IMPORTANT PUBLIC ADVISORY ON THE TWO-DAY NATIONAL FLOOD

Further to the announcement by Government on the Two-Day National Flood Aftermath Clean-up Exercise, the Ministry of Local Government, Chieftaincy and Religious Affairs, acting in line with the directive of His Excellency the President of the Republic, wishes to provide the following implementation arrangements to facilitate the effective conduct of the nationwide exercise in the seven flood-affected regions from Friday 10th July and Saturday 11th July, 2026.
